(including test methods, process reliability)

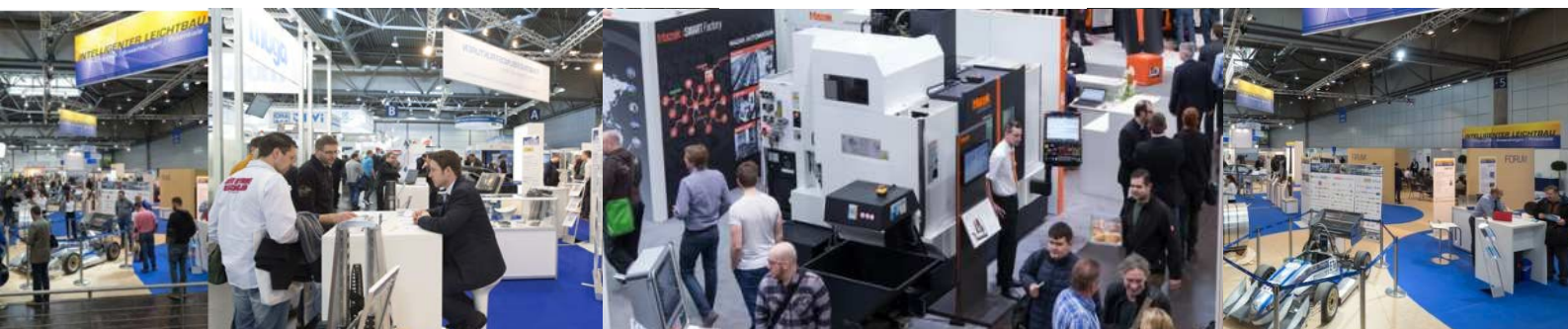
